The Employee Assistance Program offers free, professional, confidential short-term counseling, and referrals for a broad range of issues. Employees and family members are eligible to use the service at no cost.



The **EAPC** is staffed by licensed clinical social workers and consulting psychiatrists. We offer individual, couples and family counseling, and referrals for longer-term and specialized treatment and community-based services.

The **EAPC** staff can assist you with both everyday problems and crisis situations. We can help you understand and address:
